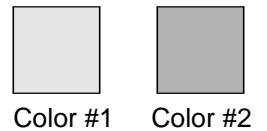


# Piecing Tutorial

working with clipped corners

**Special Instructions** - All seams are 1/4".



## Cutting the Fabric for Patchwork

Name	Qty	Size	Color
Block A	2	3-3/4" square	#1
Strip A	1	3-3/4" x 7"	#2

## Making the Block

Take both block A and trace a line (using washable pen) from corner to corner on the wrong side of the fabric. See Figure 1.

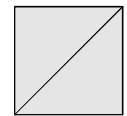

Take one block A (with line) and one strip A and lay them with right sides together as shown in Figure 2. Stitch them together using the line marked on block A. Open the strip and press as shown in Figure 3. Check strip to see if all edges line up and it looks square. Take the other block A and lay it over the strip with right sides together as shown in Figure 4. Stitch them together using the line marked on block A. Open the strip and press as shown in Figure 5. Check strip to see if all edges line up and it looks square. Bring the left corner over the strip and clip away first corner leaving a 1/4" seam as shown in Figure 6. Bring the right corner over the strip and clip away corner leaving a 1/4" seam as shown in Figure 7. Open the strip and press again. Strip should look like Figure 8.

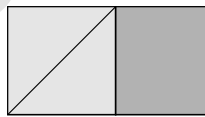

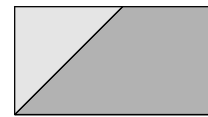

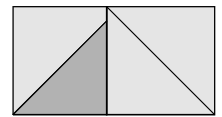

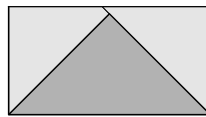

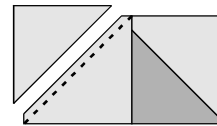

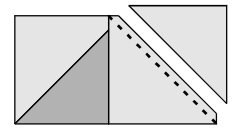
